Your Community Van is here to provide you and your neighbors with a way to share preplanned rides to local destinations throughout the day, evening and weekends. Anne Wright-Cunniff



is your new Community Transportation Coordinator and she'll be working to promote and coordinate group trips to favorite destinations and to ensure there is an approved driver and at least two riders on each trip. The success of this program relies on a willing group of volunteers ready to drive and riders ready to join preplanned trips. Riders pay a Metro fare and volunteer drivers ride for free.

PRESS RELEASE

A Transportation Benefit District (TBD) is a way to fund City street and sidewalk projects and is a new \$20.00 per year fee paid by Duvall residents at time of vehicle registration.

The Duvall City Council will hold a public hearing to consider funding of the Duvall Transportation Benefit District (TBD) on June 21, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Riverview Educational Service Center, 15510 1st Ave NE. The Mayor and Council invites public attendance to learn more about the funding proposal and the projects that would be eligible for consideration. The Council will be considering a vehicle license fee of \$20 per vehicle annually.

In late 2015, after more than two years of public discussion and deliberation, the Duvall City Council approved the formation of the TBD and now will consider a funding mechanism to sustain and enhance the maintenance and preservation of the City's roads and sidewalks.

The Council will be considering a vehicle license fee of \$20 per vehicle annually. This fee would apply to any vehicles registered within the city limits of Duvall; however, all campers, farm vehicles, mopeds, ATV's, snowmobiles and private use single axle trailers will be exempt.

If approved, as of 2016, the fee is expected to generate approximately \$116,000 annually and will provide the City with continuous, reliable funding for the Twenty Year Transportation Improvement Plan. Additionally, the City will maintain and increase its eligibility to receive grant funding awards from state and federal sources, reducing the city taxpayer share of funding large projects.

The most common TBD funding source, a vehicle license fee, is authorized by RCW 36.73.040(3) (b). If levied, the fee could remain permanent with proceeds used annually to repair, maintain and enhance the safety and usability of our local and community identified transportation needs.
