MAIN STREET PROJECT UPDATE



June was a different kind of month for work on the project. A lot of small tasks were done while waiting for the undergrounding work to be completed by our utilities.

July will get started with a bang and just keep going. The Thayer Creek culvert replacement will take place. This is a huge task toward completing our project. Please see the enclosed flyer for important information on upcoming roadwork and closures in our area.

Summer's Here- Do You Know How Much to Water?

It's heating up! Give your plants the right amount of water by following these tips:

- Watering deeply and less often is generally best. Check your soil before you water to see if the soil is still damp a few inches down. If it's dry, water enough to moisten the whole root zone (the top 6 to 12 inches of soil).
- Try drip irrigation in your planting beds instead of a hose or sprinkler. Drip irrigation delivers water right to plant roots, reducing water loss from evaporation and overspray.
- If you have an automatic sprinkler system, you can get up to a \$100 rebate for a new WaterSense timer. These timers adjust sprinkler runtimes to match the weather. To learn more, visit www.savingwater.org/ rebates.

Giving your plants the right amount of water keeps them healthy, saves water and saves money on your water bill.

FIREWORKS REGULATIONS IN DUVALL

As the weather warms and BBQs start happening, we begin to think of summer and the 4th of July Holiday. Here is a reminder of the fireworks regulations within the city limits of Duvall.



According to Duvall Municipal Code 5.10.055, "It is unlawful for a person to ignite, discharge, use, or explode any fireworks in the City of Duvall except between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. on July 4th."
