

## WHAT CAN I DO TO HELP DURING THE HOLIDAYS? HOLIDAY HELPERS -NOVEMBER 25<sup>TH</sup> - DECEMBER 20<sup>TH</sup>

The City of Duvall is partnering with Holy Innocents Outreach and Food Pantry this year for the holiday season. This program helps people throughout the Snoqualmie Valley and beyond with food, personal care items, clothing and gifts during the holidays. Their mission is "to provide service to all in need who come to seek aid." They never turn anyone away who asks for help and they are very deserving of our community's support this season.

### How the program will work:

- Beginning November 25<sup>th</sup> through December 17<sup>th</sup>, visit a local retailer with a holiday tree sign in their window and pick up a flyer outlining the items needed.
- Purchase the items and leave them (unwrapped) with any participating retailer in their designated spot.
- They will then be picked up and delivered to the outreach center for distribution.
