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## Main Street and Cherry Valley Road Sidewalk Improvement Project

**PROJECT UPDATE**

**Project Description** - The project widened Cherry Valley Road and included installation of 950 linear feet of new sidewalk and bicycle lane on Cherry Valley Road and Main Street NE (SR-203). The project also included construction of a 340-foot long textured soil nail wall to protect and stabilize the adjacent steep slope along with storm water (runoff) improvements including a bio-retention area.

**Funding** - The \$795,000 construction project was partially funded by a \$400,000 Transportation Improvement Board grant.

**TRAFFIC ALERT** - A new traffic island was installed as part of the project. The traffic island was required as part of the WSDOT approved plan and is intended to channelize traffic at the intersection. Signage and white stripe channelization is included to help define the traffic island.

**Northbound Traffic:** Traffic should be aware that the slower speeds will be required when turning onto Cherry Valley Road. The traffic island forces vehicles to treat this intersection as a standard intersection like the Virginia or Valley Street Intersections.

**Southbound:** Southbound traffic will not be impacted by the new traffic island. Road widening (addition of 4 feet of bicycle lane) improves southbound turning movements.
