At this event you can get rid of household (not commercial) recyclables that are usually difficult to recycle in our area..

You can bring:

- Household Goods and Clothes (donated to charity – NO furniture)
- Oil, Oil Filters/ Antifreeze
- Batteries – car, truck, motorcycle, and marine lead-acid batteries; household and flashlight batteries will also be accepted
- Refrigerators/Freezers (\$20 fee)
- Computers, Monitors, TVs – FREE this year!
- Other Electronics (small fax machines & copiers, phones, keyboards, and more; there are fees - call for details)
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs (50 cents each)
- Scrap Metal/Major Appliances (stove, washer, dryer, dishwasher, water heater)
- Plastic Plant Pots and Packing Peanuts (NO Styrofoam packing frames. NO other plastics: (pails, chairs, pools, etc.) and NO household or small plant pots)
- Passenger Tires (\$1 off rim/ \$2 on rim) – extra for split rim and large truck tires, call for details.

There is NO bulky garbage collection at the event this year.
