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**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF DUVALL, WASHINGTON, APPROVING THE 2011-2016  
SIX-YEAR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PLAN.**

WHEREAS, RCW 35.77.010 requires the legislative body of each city to annually prepare and adopt a comprehensive transportation program for the ensuing six year; and

WHEREAS, state law requires that the transportation program shall be consistent with the City's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the Six Year Transportation Improvement Plan prepared by staff, identified transportation priorities, and determined that the Plan is consistent with the capital facilities and transportation elements of the City's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 35.77.010, the City Council held a Public Hearing on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2010;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUVALL,  
WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The attached Exhibit "A" is adopted as the Six Year Transportation Improvement Plan of the City of Duvall and incorporated by reference the same as though it were fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to file a copy of this resolution with the Secretary of Transportation not more than thirty days after its adoption.
