Main Street Project Update

Sidewalks! After months of waiting, sidewalks have been installed along the majority of the west side of the project. Gaps remain for future connections and pole removal, but it is a definite improvement. The majority of work has shifted from the west to the east side with utility installation already in full swing. The joint trench work will steadily progress over the next few weeks, with utility crews beginning to pull wire shortly thereafter. Over the next few weeks water main tie-ins and service reconnections may also begin. Notifications will be sent out 72 hours in advance of service interruptions. The City is also bringing an electrical contractor on board to handle the electric service conversions. Additional information will follow soon.
