1. IFIT-KC: Community Representative Update
 - a) Virtual information session with Acting Chief DeBock on April 13, 2021
 - b) Open application period April 14-21, 2021
 - c) Update on number of applicants for community rep positions
 - d) Virtual interviews April 28-29, 2021
 - e) Final selections May 6, 2021
2. Police Officer Recruitment Update
 - a) Officer Pa started with our agency on April 5, 2021
 - b) Lateral candidate that did not pass the background was replaced with an entry level candidate, giving us two (2) entry level candidates in background
 - c) One (1) entry level candidate did not pass his polygraph exam
 - d) The second entry level candidate passed his exams and will be hired with a start date of May 16, 2021. He will begin his academy training on June 2, 2021 with a graduation date in October
 - e) Recruitment is ongoing for a lateral candidate to fill the last open position
3. PropertyRoom.com Discussion
 - a) City Attorney has reviewed contract
 - b) DMC 3.12 addresses purchasing policies but is silent on zero-cost contracts
 - c) Since this a contract, all contracting authority lies with Council unless delegated
 - d) Out of abundance of caution, recommendation is to put this on Council agenda
 - e) The hope is a quick one-touch approval, if agreeable
 - d) Agenda bill to council at 5/4 meeting
4. Water Safety Update
 - a) Lt. Sabourin reached out to WCIA regarding 'no wake zone' signage and community life-jacket program
 - b) WCIA is recommending that 'no wake zone' signage is fine, with enforcement
 - c) WCIA has not changed their recommendation on the life-jacket program
 - d) Life-jackets would need to be new and inspected regularly
 - e) Signage would need to be available explaining how to properly use the life jackets
 - f) Life-jackets would need to be repaired or replaced when damaged
