2026 Utility Billing Rates City utility rates are reviewed and adjusted each year as needed to cover the increased cost of operations. In 2026, the base utility rate increases will only affect the city stormwater rates. This increase is necessary to manage citywide regulations and the needs of the stormwater system, which are largely dictated by state and federal requirements.
