## Emergency Preparedness

Emergencies can happen when we least expect them, from severe weather and power outages to floods or wildfires. Preparing ahead of time helps keep you, your family, and our Duvall community safe. Every household should have an emergency kit stocked with essentials such as food, water, flashlights, batteries, and a first-aid kit. Don't forget important medications, pet supplies, and copies of key documents.

Just as important is having a family communication plan. Make sure everyone in your household knows where to meet if you become separated and how to get in touch if phone service is disrupted. Staying informed is also critical. Sign up for local alerts through King County's ALERT system and follow the City of Duvall for updates.

Waste Management will be hosting a Community Clean-Up Day on Saturday, October 11, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the Taylor Landing Boat Launch (16201 Main St NE).

Residents are encouraged to bring bagged trash, nonhazardous waste, household recyclables, furniture, bulky items, appliances, and yard waste for proper disposal.

Please note that some items cannot be accepted at this event, such as hazardous waste, electronics, concrete, construction debris, gasoline, pesticides, cleaning materials, rocks, sod, large trees, and any trash that is not bagged or bundled. Questions?
