



**STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT
WAC 197-11-970
DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)**

Description of Proposal: The City is proposing the adoption of the 2024 Transportation Plan (TP), a non-project that aligns with the Puget Sound Regional Council's (PSRC) Vision 2050 (<https://www.psrc.org/planning-2050/vision-2050>), a multicounty framework guiding planning policies, actions, and regional growth strategies. The TP focuses on key elements, including Existing Transportation Services and Facilities, Forecasts for Future Transportation Conditions, and the Transportation Systems Plan. It advances the City's established goals and policies by identifying potential road construction projects and creating a 20-year project list supported by a comprehensive finance and implementation plan. The City's transportation model has been updated to reflect Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE) trip generation rates and industry best practices, ensuring a data-driven approach to planning. Any project actions recommended in the TP that influence future development will undergo additional environmental evaluation as required.
